I. CP Proposal

1.1. Problem Definition

1.1.1. Name of this Capstone Project

Colours of Love (Sắc màu của Tình yêu).

Our short film is about love by using water colors to represent every characters. The main goal is to show love through the different shades based on color.

1.1.2. Problem Abstraction

Reflecting the thought of refusing the past of others without sympathy, “judging the book by his cover” as forgiving each other’s mistakes.

1.2. Project Overview

1.2.1. Ideas

Through the humanization of water color, “Colours of Love” is a short 2D animated movie based on the typical love story, through which we want to send this message to all the viewers: “Don’t judge people through their past, love means forgiving, healing and completing each other”.

This movie is about a man and his broken heart. After finding the ugly past of his lover, he feels so lost and scared, all he wants to do is to escape the present and leave everything behind. From the escape, he is attracted by many other girls. He did try hard to match and blend with them but that was impossible. Only when he almost loses everything that he realized he ain’t no different than his girlfriend in the old days and she is the one for him.

1.2.2. Tools of Development

After years of research and study in art areas, we have had the chance to have hand-on experiences with tools to express our idea, and water color is one of those.

Water color is formed by blending colors with water, creating a beautiful substance. The traditional canvas for water color to show off its beauty is paper. Along with paper, papyrus, plastic, parchment, leather and wood are also water color’s affiliates. The basic features of

water color are transparency and light, as well as purity and intensity of the color base. These features are due to the light amount of color which is always placed onto paper. As its name stated, water color is water-based, which makes it evaporates very fast (which is different from oil color). This makes water color convenient for carrying and painting regardless the location. Water color and their tools are easy to washed.

The good thing about water color is that it allows users to combine different base colors together to create a new unique shade just by blending and mixing them. When the number of colors being mixed are too many, the percentage of water will increased, which ruins everything, turning all these colors to the grey shade, which is normally know as “dirty” shade. Usually, you have to wash away these colors, but to some artists, they can utilize these colors by using a condensed base color to create a new mixture

Painting with water colors requires a whole set of skills, flexibility and most important is the right preservation. If water color is left aside for a long period of time, it will become to thick for painting. Some even contain mould. You can save some by mixing the dry color with water and stir thoroughly for a couple of minutes.

By humanizing water color, we have created a world that is filled with activity, which means that everything and everyone have to be active in order to survive. As we mentions previously, water color will be thickened and not usable if being left aside.

Due to the light and flexible feature of water color, we have chosen dancing and singing along with instruments to represent the constant movements of the characters. In terms of dancing, ballet and dancing are simply the top choices to present the movement and personality of the characters. However, both methods are limited in the ways to express feelings. Therefore, in order to easily blend things up, we choose the random modern dance. Besides, all of the characters also express their feelings through actions and music. They do not use narration as usual in order for the dancing to be presented at its fullest.

After many researches, we have decided to go with “frame by frame” animation method in order to bring the most natural movements and controlable spinning of the characters when they dance. Besides, we also used After Effect to animate the side characters and create color changing effects as well as scene changing for the whole movie.

And final, the background is intentionally simplified so as to match with the story’s plot, which is basically abstract, unclear and blurry.

II. Design Proposal

2.1. Script

- Camera slowly moving down -

The appearance of 2 main white characters who were dancing Rhumba (a slow romantic love dance).

- After a rotation, camera begin to zoom into the male character's hand -

The male character recognized a strange color on the girl's body, then touched it with curiosity. Instantly, the color spread over him, making him scared and then he stepped back (the color stopped spreading and disappeared). The male character hastily left the girl.

- Camera's movement is based on the male character from now -

The male character was attracted by the melody of an instrument, he then followed it. Then, he saw a yellow female character playing passionately with her violin.

The male character approached and started dancing around the yellow girl, then his own color changed (his moves were no longer a slow dance which he made with the main girl).

For a couple seconds, another music instrument sound appeared, gaining interest on the male character's attention and he once again followed it.

He saw a red woman who played guitar, he started to dance next to her with his new moves and color.

Even more curious music instrument sound resounded, made The male character left.

In front of him was a blue woman playing the piano, his footsteps followed the slow melody.

Recognize his interest, the blue female speed up the beat and The male character started to dance furiously.

After a while, other females that brought their own instruments showed up around him, the male character danced non-stop. In order to merge everything together, his color changed continuously. The melody then sounded strangely weird, and chaos.

- A random character goes across the screen, constantly changing scenes -

The male character knelt down, begging for help.

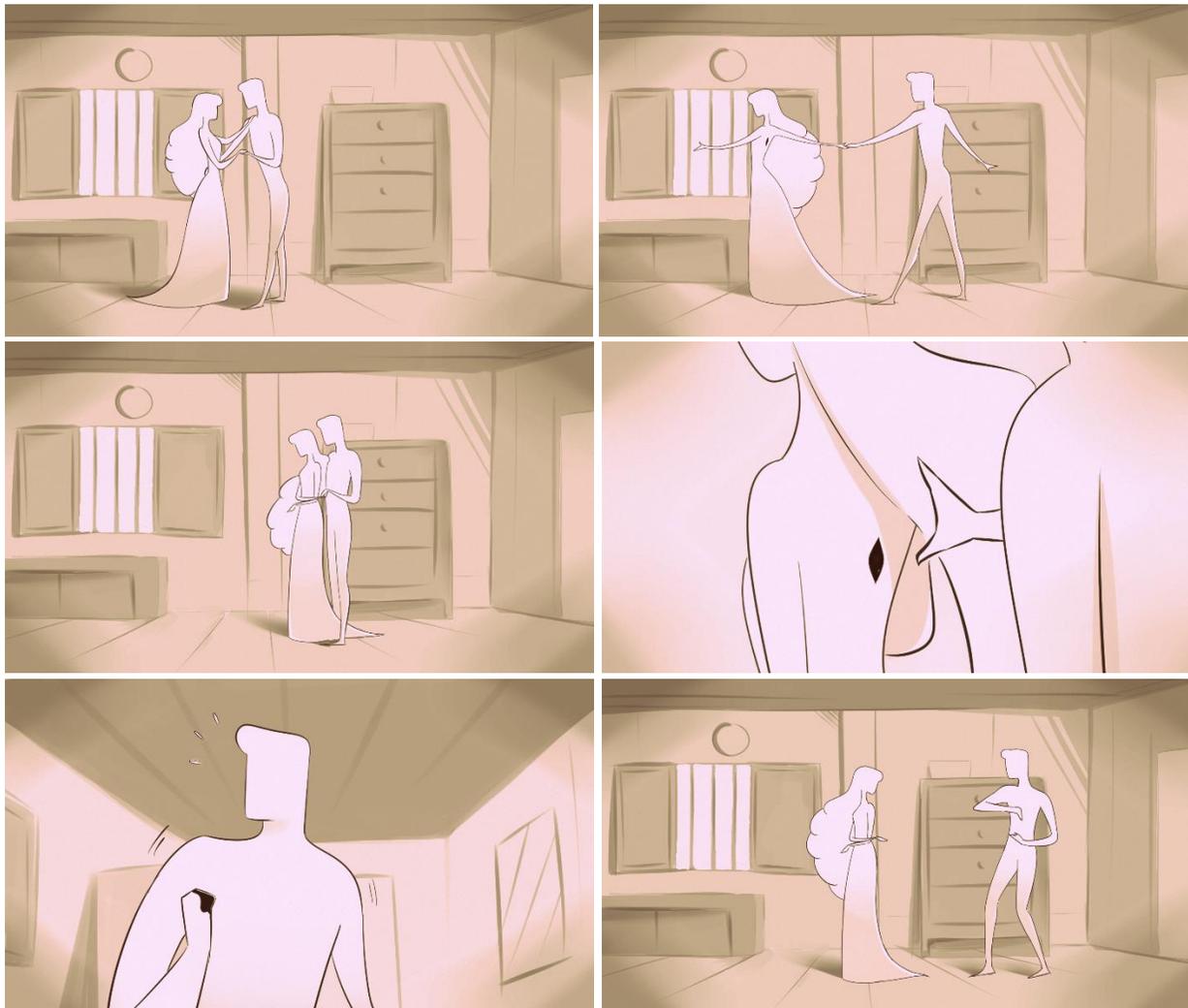
Unexpectedly, the main girl appeared, approached and touched The male character. The dark sight vanished and became brighter just like before. The male character transformed, back to his beginning.

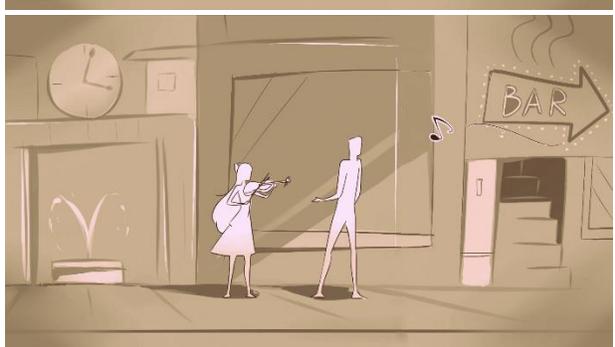
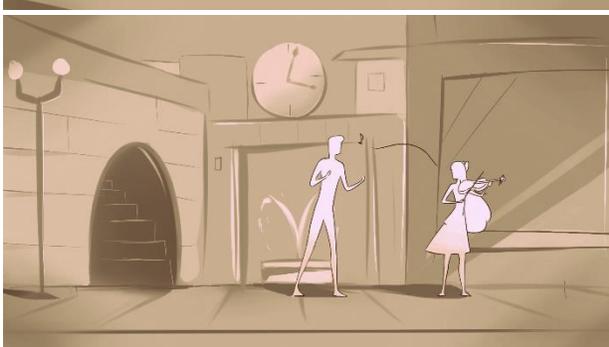
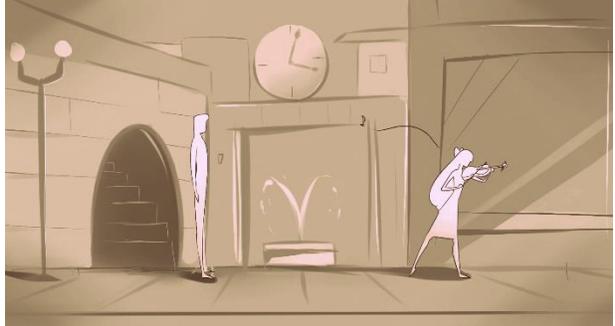
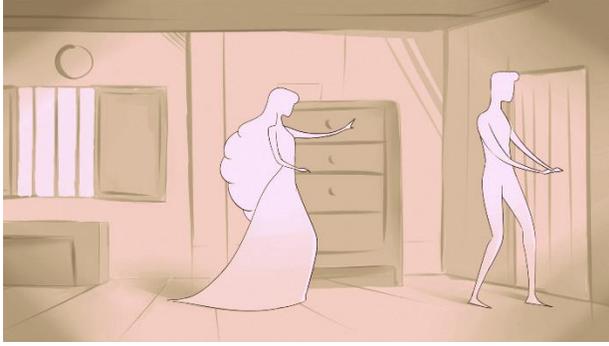
The main girl helped The male character stand up and lead him to her own dance. They danced together once again. And the music sounded smooth again.

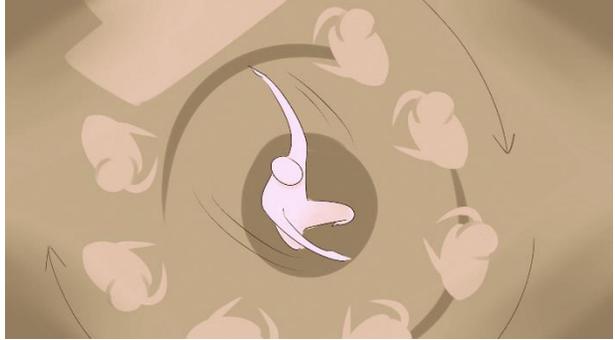
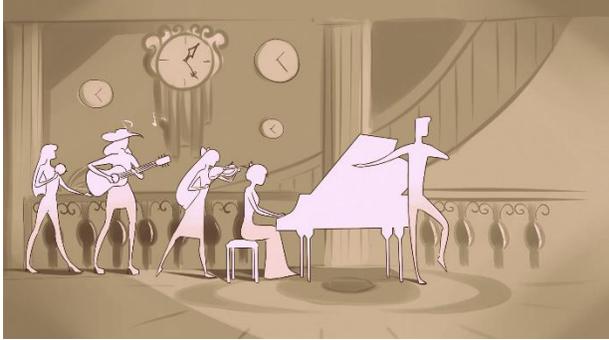
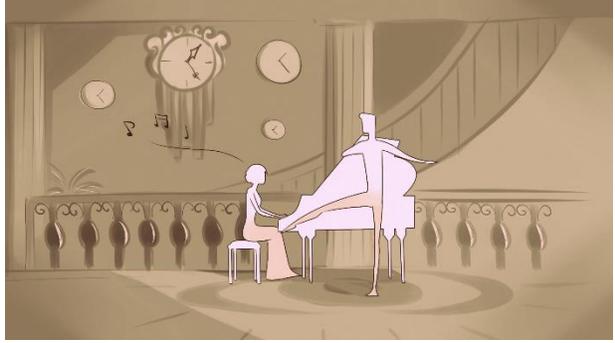
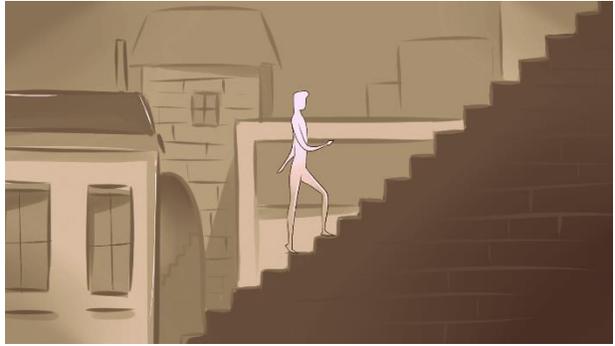

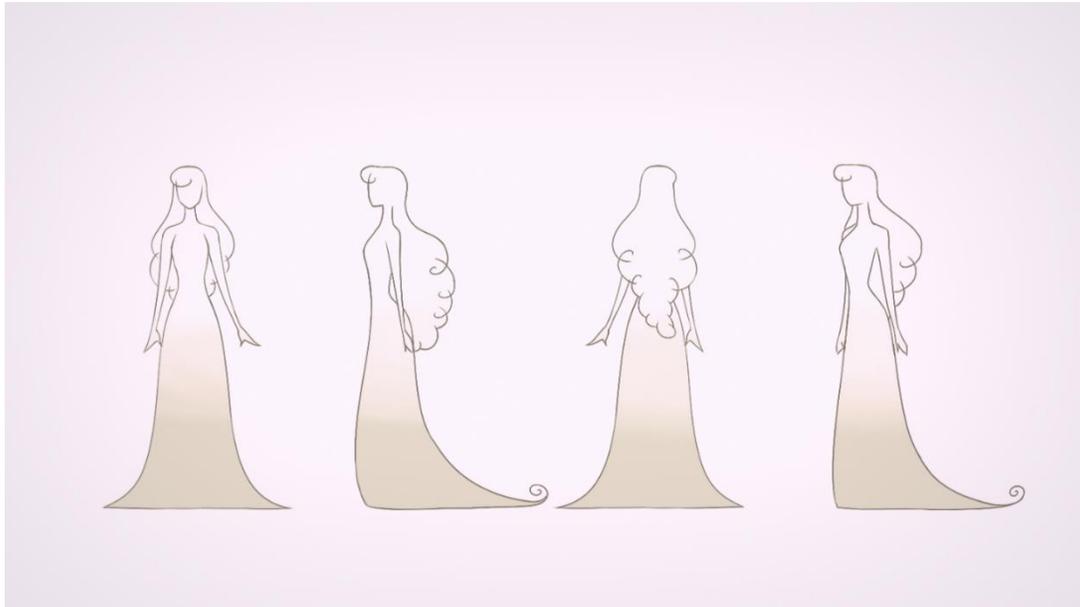
3.1. Characters Design

3.1.1. Size Comparison Chart

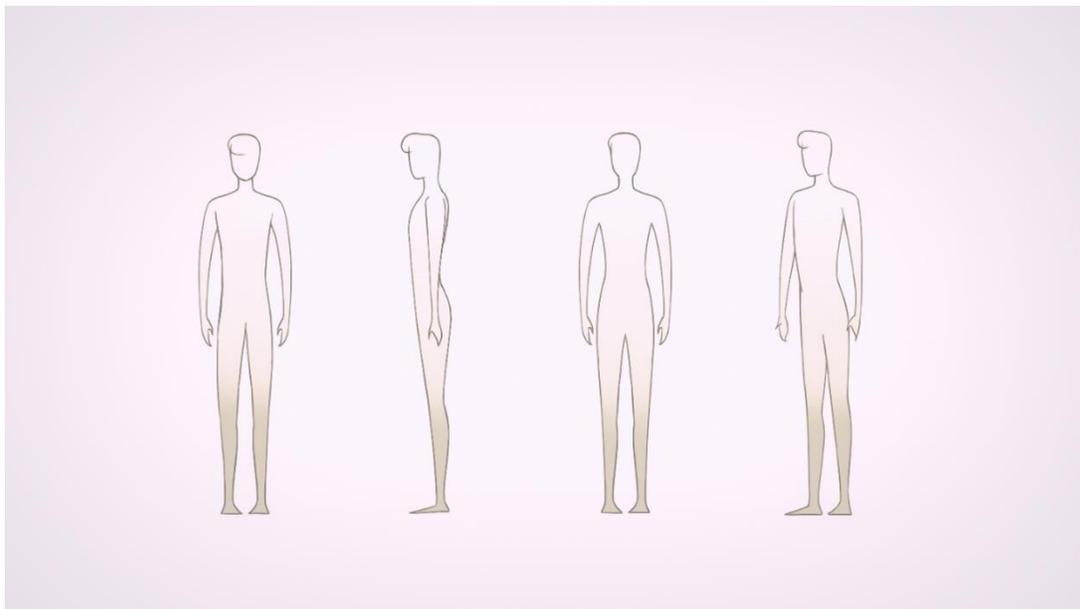


From Left to Right: Female Main Character, Male Main Character, The Red Woman, The Yellow Girl, The Blue Woman

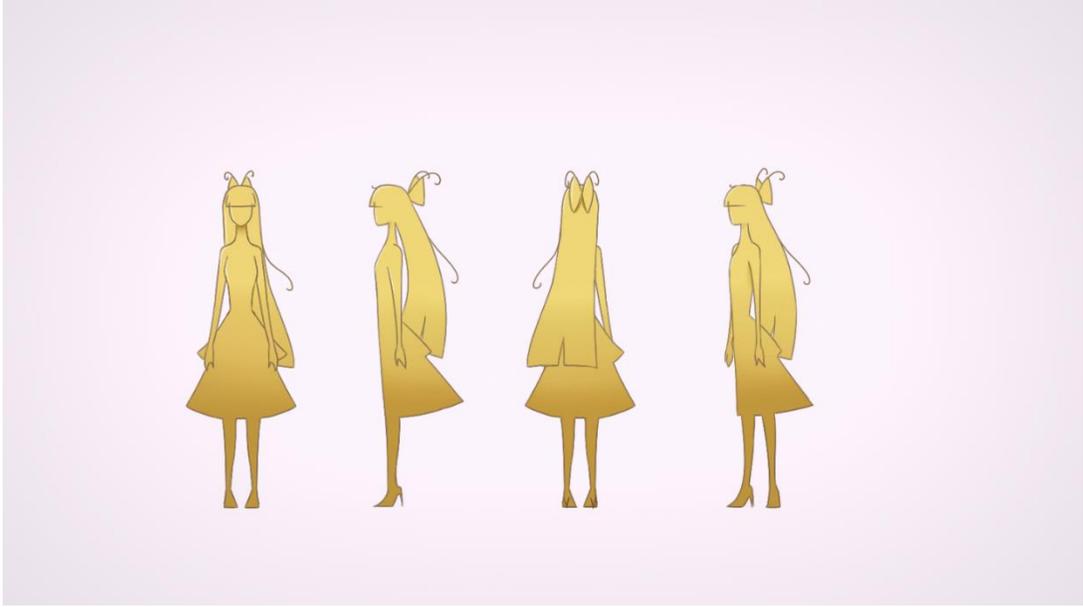
3.1.2. Design characters from different views (posing)



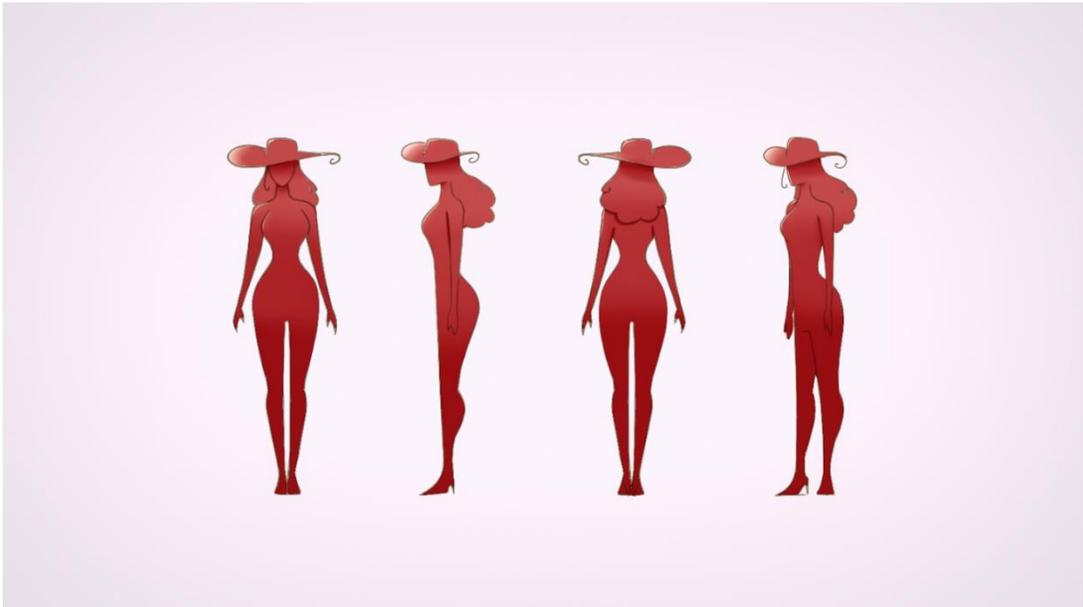
The Female Main Character (Singer)

Scene 2: This is where our main character met the Yellow Violinist. This scene remains until he moved into the next girl.



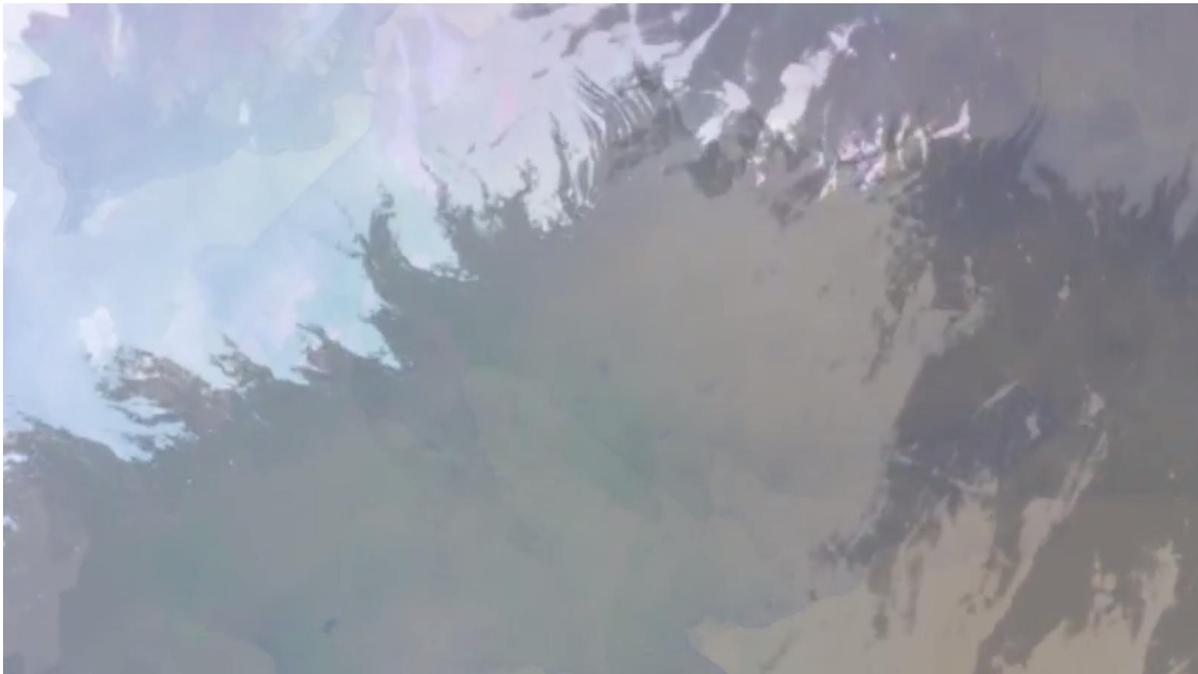
Scene 3: The scene between our main character and the Red Guitarist. This scene remains until he moved into the next girl aswell.



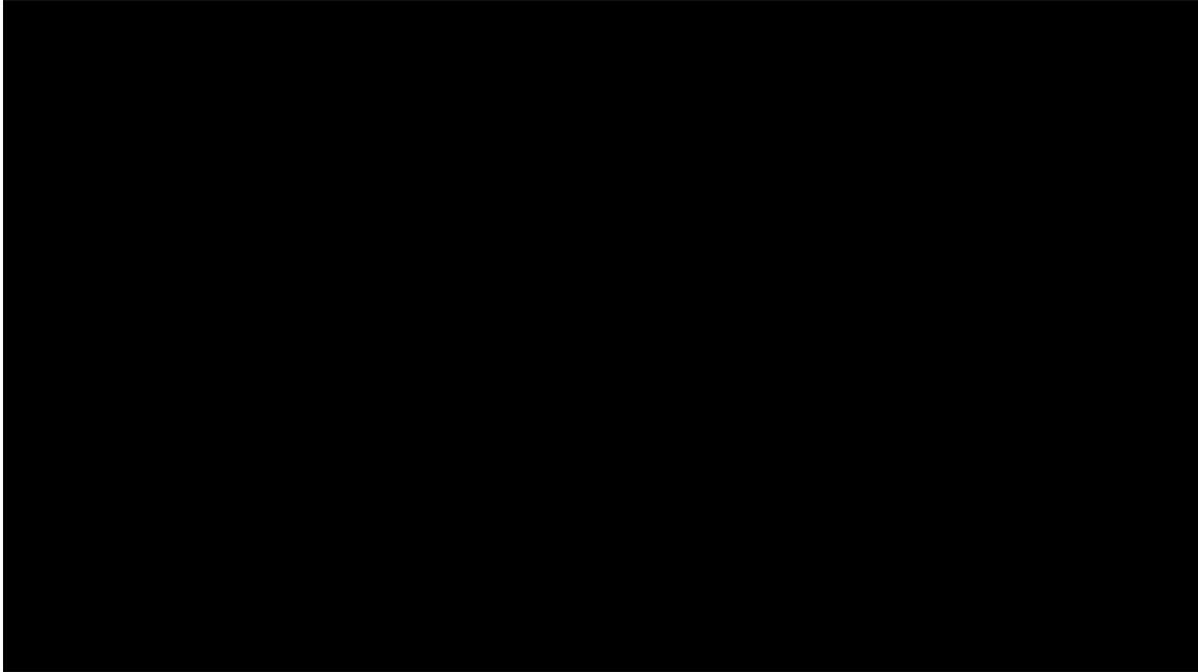
Scene 4: This is where the main character met the Blue Pianist. He started to dance furiously.

Scene 7: The female main character came and touch the male character. His shape and color is coming back and the background aswell.



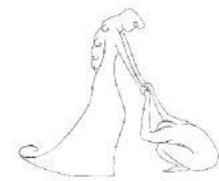
Scene 8: Once again, they dance together until the end of the movie.
